

## **CCNP 2023 Meeting**

45th Annual Meeting September 21-23, 2023 Toronto, ON



#### Dear Colleagues:

We would like to invite you to propose symposia for the 2023 meeting of the **Canadian College of Neuropsychopharmacology** to be held at the Faculty Club (41 Willcocks St, Toronto, ON M5S 3G3) from September 21-23, 2023.

Symposia proposal should include:

- (1) identification of the Chair(s),
- (2) a brief synopsis of the symposium theme (~ half a page),
- (3) a confirmed list of 3 speakers, including institutional affiliations, and
- (4) tentative titles plus a brief summary of each talk (3-4 sentences).
  - Each of the 3 presentations will last 20 minutes which allow for a 15-min presentation and a 5 min discussion period.
  - An individual cannot be listed as a presenter on more than 1 submitted proposal
  - The registration fee for speakers will be waived

Symposia should focus on topics that are timely and of broad interest to the CCNP membership. Multi-institutional submissions with a translational component and a mix of junior and senior researchers are considered a strength. We encourage individuals from equity seeking groups and reflecting the diversity of Canadian society to be included as presenters.
